... recycles The Beatles "Yesterday" after it has been digitally remasticated by Max/msp and through the jaws of chaos, accompanied by gamelan.

Telling Time

Miguel Frasconi

For gamelan and glass. A highly structured ensemble improvisation in which each performer makes choices according to the rules of the composition as a way of telling a story about the experience of time.

Naked We Stand

David Simons

The music is based upon a Phillipine *kulintang* concept of shared melody. Each of the three sections is composed of three interlocking parts, each with it's own pitch and rhythm. The title refers to the process of adding and subtracting the parts, so that the structure and elements stand "naked."
